The California Unemployment Insurance (UI) program pays benefits to workers who have lost their jobs and meet the program's eligibility requirements.¹ Most UI activity such as enrollment and certification is completed online. There are complete instructions and videos to walk you through the process online.

UI staff offices and phone lines are very busy. Wait times on the phone can often be frustrating. Officials suggest that you first try to find answers to your questions online or in your UI paperwork. Offices are open from 8 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday-Friday, except on California state holidays. If you need to visit an office, it is advised that you arrive promptly at 8 a.m.
